

## 5 Setting comb raisers using 'Gunfit' - establishing the cast

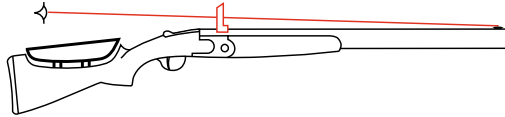


Figure A - 'Gunfit' in position

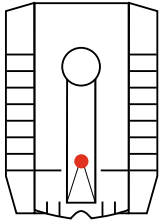


Figure B - Correct cast

Place 'Gunfit' at breech (figure A).

Move the adjustable stock until you have the correct cast (figure B).

Secure the adjustable comb in cast position.



## 6 Setting comb raisers using 'Gunfit' - establishing the height

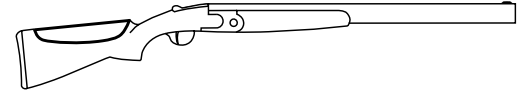


Figure A - Stock in the lowest position

To set the height of your adjustable stock, start with the adjustable stock in its lowest position (figure A). Raise the stock 1/8" (2mm) at a time and test-fire. Always ensure that your stock is properly secured each time before firing.

Keep raising the stock until you are getting good breaks, then place 'Gunfit' in position (figure B). Move the adjustable plate upwards until you are getting a correct sight picture (figure C). Lock 'Gunfit' in position.

Please note: Do not fire the shotgun with 'Gunfit' in position.

'Gunfit' can now be kept locked for future set-up for new purchases.

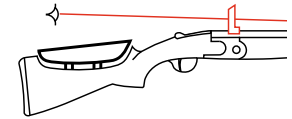


Figure B - 'Gunfit' in position

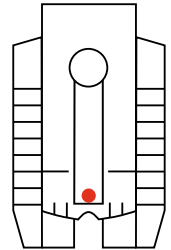


Figure C - Correct height
